# **Purpose of CCA**

- An opportunity for students to discover their interests and talents
- Develop CCA-specific knowledge, skills progressively through sustained participation
- Platforms to learn core values, social and emotional competencies and the emerging 21st Century Competencies
- Develop a sense of identity & belonging to the school

# **CCA Participation of Students**

- CCA participation is compulsory for all students in secondary schools
  - All students should take up a **SCHOOL-BASED** CCA.

Students may choose to participate in more than one CCA in order to broaden their experiences and learn a wider range of skills.



# A Holistic Education for Secondary School Students - LEAPS 2.0 Recognition System for Co-Curricular Attainment

### **LEAPS 2.0**

- to recognise students' holistic development
- Recognition of attainments in 4 domains
  - Participation
  - Achievement
  - Leadership
  - Service

## **LEAPS 2.0 – Intent & Purpose of each domain**

### **Participation Domain:**

- Affirms students' <u>sustained development</u> in school-based CCA throughout secondary school
- Regular Attendance (>75%) every year

#### **Achievement Domain:**

- Affirms students' <u>character development and efforts</u> in representing the school/ external organisations in events
- Students' diverse interests and talents are recognised as events can go beyond CCA and beyond school

# **LEAPS 2.0 – Intent & Purpose of each domain**

### Leadership


- Affirms students' development as a leader
- Students are developed through
  - leadership development workshops to learn leadership knowledge and skills, and
  - opportunities to take up leadership responsibilities to apply their learning

# **LEAPS 2.0 – Intent & Purpose of each domain**

### **Service**

- Affirms students' contributions to the community and development as <u>responsible and active citizens</u>
- Students serve the community through schools' Values-In-Action programmes such as class VIA

### LEAPS 2.0: 4 domains with levels of attainment (1 – 5) for each domain



## 3. CCA and LEAPS 2.0

Co-Curricular Attainment	Details
Excellent (2 bonus points)	Student who attains a minimum Level 3 in all four domains with at least a Level 4 in one domain.
Good (1 bonus point)	Student who attains a minimum Level 1 in all four domains with any one of the following:  i. At least Level 2 in three domains;  ii. At least Level 2 in one domain and at least Level 3 in another domain; or  iii. At least Level 4 in one domain.
Fair	Student's attainment in co-curricular will not translate into any bonus points

# You can discuss the following with your child when selecting her CCA:

- 1. Identify her interests and strengths
  - what she is interested in and what she is good at.
- 2. Setting objectives
  - kind of person your child wants to be, types of values and life skills should she develop in?
- 3. Encourage self-directed learning
  - opportunities that help support the development she wants to pursue
- 4. Managing commitments
  - ability to cope, support in her learning pursuits



### **CCA SELECTION TRIALS**

- 25, 26 & 30 Jan 2023
- Shortlist to attend trials by some CCAs based on choices in online option
- May require to attend trials for up to 4 CCAs
- Purpose of trial students' readiness to participate in regular training with the CCA



## **CCA Allocation**

Allocation of CCA will be based on

- vacancies available,
- pupil's options and
- results of selection trials.

#### APPEAL FOR CHANGE IN CCA ALLOCATION

Student to attend the given CCA until the results of the appeal.

### **SUCCESSFUL APPEAL:**

 Join the reallocated CCA. All attendance from the 1<sup>st</sup> CCA given transferred to new CCA.

### **UNSUCCESSFUL APPEAL:**

- Remain in the CCA you already were given.
- Another chance to apply for change of CCA at end of year.
